

God's Anointing: It Breaks Every Stronghold

A. You Have Received His Anointing



Special vessels for the Master's use: ...vessels of honor ...channels of His power. We each carry a **de** _____ of the pool of His anointing, that when merged with other believers, becomes a very powerful river.

I John 2: 20 & 27 *"But you have an **anointing** (unction) from the Holy One, and you know all things... besides you hold your anointing **from the Holy One.**" (Ber.)*

*"But the anointing which you have received of Him **ab** _____ in you, and you need not that any man teach you, but as the **same anointing teaches you** of all things, and is truth and is not a lie, even as it's taught you, and you shall abide in Him."*

1. You've received an anointing from the Holy One, {although you sometimes feel unanointed}.
2. This anointing of the Holy Spirit will cause you to know all things, {in time}.
3. This anointing abides within you. You are a spiritual **res** _____, {a holding place for the Holy Spirit}.

I John 2: 27 *But they (the anti-christs) are no match for what is **embedded deeply** within you -- **Christ's anointing**, no less! You don't need any of their so-called teaching. Christ's anointing teaches you the truth on everything you need to know about yourself and Him, **uncontaminated** by a single lie. Live deeply in what you were taught. **Live deeply in Christ.** (The Message Bible)*

B. Every Bondage Destroyed Because of the Anointing - Isaiah 10: 20, 24 & 27

verse 20 - It will come about ... that the remnant of Israel and those of the house of Judah who have escaped, will never again rely on the one who struck them, but will truly rely on the Lord, the Holy One of Israel.

verse 24 - ...thus says the Lord God of hosts, "O My people who dwell in Zion, do not fear the Assyrian who strikes you with the rod and lifts up his staff against you, the way Egypt did".

verse 27 - So it will be in that day, that his **bur** _____ (the King of Assyria) will be removed from your shoulders and his yoke from your neck, and the yoke will be broken because of fatness (other translations) ...will be broken **because of** the anointing.



Any oppression, any bondage, any burden can be broken and **des _____ by the power of God!**

This Scripture is referring to the **div** prosperity and anointing that God released in Israel. The help that God gave them caused such growth; the yoke could no longer remain in place around their neck.

Isaiah 10: 27 - *“The yolk shall be destroyed because of **the fatness** [which prevents it from any longer going around your neck]” (Amp.)*
*“and destroyed has been the yoke by **the (abu** prosperity.”*
 [YLT]

God’s anointing, His abundant prosperity...
 true fatness (richness of oil) is our resource in reserve.

Anointing : [Heb. lang.] (shemen): prime root meaning to grease, esp. liquid, as from the olive; often perfumed; figuratively: richness, the anointing.

Things, in their season, that grew plump or ripe represent the quality of fruitfulness; oil or oiled, the anointment. To make oily, become or wax fat.

Life Point: Through Christ, the fullness of God’s anointing has been released and **emp** through the Holy Spirit.

He dwells in His people, and this is a people who are... **called to live their life fl** and ministering in this powerful anointing.

C. Functions of the Anointing



Throughout the Bible, in the Old and New Testaments, the definition “to anoint” is systematically the same.

It means “to smear with oil, to besmear, to consecrate to an office for religious service (devotion)”. As we worship, we have the privilege of anointing the Lord with our worship.

1. The anointing of eyes for vision:

Revelation 3: 18 I advise you to buy from Me:

- a. gold refined by fire (true spiritual richness),
- b. white garments to clothe yourselves (covering your spiritual nakedness) and
- c. eye salve to anoint your eyes, that you might see.

Anoint: (Greek) egchrio - to rub in, to oil, besmear, from the idea “to paint” to consecrate to an office for a religious service, to rub, smear or anoint.

2. To consecrate or **sanctify** - Set apart unto the Lord:

Anoint : (Hebrew) mascham- to rub with oil, to consecrate, also to **pa** .

Ex 28: 41... and you (Moses) shall **anoint them**, ordain (Aaron and his sons), consecrate them.

Ex 29: 7... take the anointing oil, pour it upon his head and anoint him (for **pri** ministry).

3. The promise of salvation and mercy for His anointed: The Lord will save (free and **av** _____) His anointed!

Psalm 20: 5 - 6 *We will sing for joy over your victory (salvation), and in the name of our God we will set up our banners, may the Lord fulfill all of your petitions.*

*Now I know that **the Lord saves His anointed**; He will answer from His holy Heaven, with the saving strength of His right hand.*

*Now I know that the Lord saves {frees... avenges... and gets **vi** for} His anointed.*

4. Jesus anointed with the Holy Spirit and power - This set the pattern for us.

Acts 10: 37 - 38 *You yourselves know the thing which took place throughout all Judea, starting from Galilee, after the baptism which John proclaimed,*

*“You know of Jesus of Nazareth, how God anointed Him with the Holy Spirit and with **power** and how He went about doing good and **healing** all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him”.*

5. Anointed with **fr** _____ oil... The oil of joy belongs to God’s anointed.

Psalm 92: 10 - 12 *But You have exalted my horn like that of a wild ox; [The horn is the emblem of great strength (excessive) and stately grace.] I’ve been anointed with **fresh oil**.*

*God **rev** _____ my failing strength. (Mof.)*

*I am refreshed by Your blessing {anointing} and my eyes have seen the downfall of my enemies... the righteous man will **flo** like a palm tree. (Mof.)*

Psalm 45: 7 - *You have **loved** righteousness and **hated** wickedness; therefore God, our God has... **anointed you with the oil of gla** _____ above all your fellows.*
(KJV)

God has anointed you with sweet-smelling oil above all your associates. (Har.)
